Columbia River and Tributary Fishery Reports

Fishery Reports:

Salmon/Steelhead:

Mainstem Lower Columbia River

Sec 1 (Bonneville) – 69 bank anglers kept six Chinook, three Chinook jacks, two coho and three coho jacks. 19 boat/56 rods kept 36 Chinook, seven Chinook jacks and released one Chinook, five Chinook jacks and one coho.

Sec 2 (Camas/Washougal) – 42 boats/105 rods kept 49 Chinook, six Chinook jacks, one coho and released four Chinook, one Chinook jack and one coho jack.

Sec 4 (Vancouver) – 30 bank anglers kept one Chinook jack, one coho and released one coho jack. 60 boats/146 rods kept 41 Chinook, seven Chinook jacks, four coho and released two Chinook jacks, three coho and one coho jack.

Sec 5 (Woodland) – 32 boats/87 rods kept 14 Chinook, one Chinook jack and one coho.

Sec 6 (Kalama) – 147 bank anglers kept 15 Chinook. 51 boats/137 rods kept 40 Chinook, three Chinook jacks, four coho and released seven Chinook, two Chinook jacks and five coho.

Sec 7 (Cowlitz) – 28 boats/76 rods kept 33 Chinook, two Chinook jacks, two coho and released two Chinook and five coho.

Sec 8 (Longview) – 28 bank anglers kept one Chinook and one coho. 25 boats/51 rods kept 15 Chinook, one Chinook jack, one coho jack and released one coho.

Sec 9 (Cathlamet) – 5 boats/12 rods kept three Chinook.

Sturgeon:

Sec 1 (Bonneville) – 66 bank anglers had no catch. 2 boats/4 rods had no catch.

Sec 2 (Camas/Washougal) – 3 boats/8 rods released two sublegal sturgeon.

Sec 4 (Vancouver) – 12 bank anglers had no catch. 21 boats/62 rods kept four legal and released 12 sublegal and 10 oversized sturgeon.

Sec 5 (Woodland) – 13 boats/34 rods kept four legal and released seven sublegal and one oversized sturgeon.

Sec 6 (Kalama) – 18 bank anglers had no catch. 65 boats/179 rods kept 13 legal and released 78 sublegal and 10 oversized sturgeon.

Sec 7 (Cowlitz) – 7 boats/22 rods kept three legal and released six sublegal sturgeon.

Sec 8 (Longview) – 58 bank anglers released three sublegal sturgeon. 10 boats/31 rods kept one legal sturgeon.

Sec 9 (Cathlamet) – 8 boats/19 rods kept one legal and released four sublegal sturgeon.

Salmon/Steelhead:

Columbia River Tributaries

Cowlitz River – I-5 Br downstream – 46 bank anglers kept one coho, two coho jacks and released one Chinook jack and one sublegal sturgeon. 49 boats/114 rods kept six coho, five coho jacks, one steelhead, three legal sturgeon and released nine Chinook, two Chinook jacks, one coho, 22 sublegal and five oversized sturgeon.

Above the I-5 Br – Four bank anglers kept one coho and released three Chinook. 2 boats/5 rods kept one coho, two cutthroat and released one Chinook.

Lewis River – Two bank anglers had no catch.

Drano Lake – 26 bank anglers kept two Chinook and released four steelhead. 77 boats/180 rods kept 89 Chinook, 11 Chinook jacks, seven coho, one coho jack and released five Chinook, one Chinook jack, one coho and one steelhead.
