On behalf of WDFW, I am responding to the comments raised in Ecology's review of the SEPA associated with Ecology file No. 202300120 (attached).

- 1) Regarding SEA program concerns of development within the 100 year floodplain, WDFW acknowledges that all necessary permitting associated with the proposed use will be completed prior to installation. Coordination with Franklin county is expected to be completed as part of a forthcoming engineering and design phase of the project.
- 2) Regarding WR program comments related to obtaining proper water right authorizations, WDFW is currently working with OCR staff to process application no. S3-29444. No construction or use of water will be pursued until a final permit is issued.
- 3) WDFW acknowledges that any other requirements for the project must be complied with beyond those raised in this review. WDFW will ensure close coordination with all parties involved with permitting and approvals for the proposed project.
