Columbia River and Tributary Fishery Reports

Mainstem Columbia River

Salmon/Steelhead:

Sec 1 (Bonneville) – 43 bank anglers kept six Chinook, two coho, one coho jack and released one Chinook. 3 boats/4 rods kept two Chinook.

Sec 2 (Camas/Washougal) – 8 boats/12 rods kept one Chinook.

Sec 3 (I-5 area) – No report.

Sec 4 (Vancouver) – One bank angler had no catch. 6 boats/10 rods kept two Chinook and released one Chinook.

Sec 5 (Woodland) – No report.

Sec 6 (Kalama) – Four bank anglers had no catch.

Sec 7 (Cowlitz) – No report.

Sec 8 (Longview) – No report.

Sec 9 (Cathlamet) – No report.

Columbia River Tributaries

Salmon/Steelhead:

Cowlitz River I-5 Br downstream – 30 bank rods kept one coho jack. 2 boats/8 rods kept one coho jack and released one coho.

Cowlitz River Above the I-5 Br – 33 bank rods kept one coho jack and released two Chinook and two coho jacks.

Kalama River – Eight bank rods released two steelhead.

Lewis River – 39 bank rods kept eight coho, one coho jack and released two Chinook and five coho. 5 boats/8 rods kept two coho and released one Chinook and six coho.

Wind River – 3 boats/8 rods kept one coho.

Drano Lake – 14 bank rods released two Chinook and one coho. 21 boats/41 rods kept five Chinook, nine coho and released four Chinook.

Klickitat River below Fisher Hill Bridge – Eight bank rods kept two coho.

Klickitat River above #5 Fishway – Two bank rods had no catch. 2 boats/5 rods kept one Chinook.
