Dear Recreational Halibut Angler:

The Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) met in Seattle, Washington this week to consider proposed changes to the Council's Pacific Halibut Catch Sharing Plan (CSP) for 2019.

The Council approved all of the changes recommended by the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) at the September meeting. Changes for consideration include revising the season opening date and the days open per week for the Columbia River subarea (Marine Area 1) and revising the structure of the nearshore fishery in the south coast subarea (Marine Area 2). Please see the WDFW report (attached) for more details.

The Council will approve final changes to the CSP at their meeting on November 1-8, 2018, in San Diego, California, giving time for the state agencies to work with stakeholders to discuss and refine the changes approved for public review at the September Council meeting and discuss halibut season dates for 2019. To facilitate additional input, we have scheduled a meeting for October 9, 2018, at the Montesano City Hall starting at 9:00 AM. The Montesano City Hall is located at 112 N. Main Street, Montesano, WA, 98563.
