Asotin County Ordinance (10-21) restricting motorized vessels on the Grande Ronde River

For the WA portion of the Grande Ronde R, motorized watercraft are prohibited from Sept 15 to March 15, unless the river is 3,000 cfs or greater, or vessels are used for enforcement or emergency. For more information, contact Asotin County, or see the BLM website:

Boating requires self-issued, free, BLM river permits available at access points, along with a portable toilet, life jackets and a fire pan. Motorized watercraft is prohibited upstream of the OR-WA state line at all times. Also, please see the WA state boating requirements link available on this BLM website page.


