Agency: Department of Fish and Wildlife

Subject of possible rule making: Development of rules regarding recreational access to Department Lands.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: 77.04.055, 77.32.050, 77.32.090, 77.32.380

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: New rules are needed to implement SSSB 5622, the Discover Washington Pass bill, to provide recreational access to Department lands.
