Background:

In April 2010, significant changes were made to the special hunting permit application process. Up to eight application categories were created for permit hunts for an individual species. The categories included: youth, senior, disabled, antlerless, second deer, master hunter, buck or bull, and quality hunt. There were many concerns expressed during the public input process leading to Commission adoption of these changes. To address these concerns, the Commission requested this review of the first year results.

Policy Issue(s) you are bringing to the Commission for consideration:

A review of the results of changes to the special hunting permit application process.

Public involvement process used and what you learned:

During the public process leading to Commission adoption of changes to the special permit application process, the public expressed several concerns about what would happen to applicants. Many were concerned about the impacts on drawing odds and how the changes would impact an individual's points and likelihood of drawing a permit.
