Why do we want to know about fishers?

Fishers disappeared from the Olympic Peninsula and Washington by the mid-1900s. They have been reintroduced in Olympic National Park to begin restoring the species in the state. The recovery of dead fishers will help us monitor the reintroduction's success. Thank you!

What's a fisher?

- A large, dark-brown member of the weasel family, about the size of a house cat
- **Weight:** males 8-12 pounds; females 4-7 pounds
- **Length** (tip of nose to end of tail): males 35-47 inches; females 30-37 inches
