### **Area 2A and 2D:**

- **Live box use REQUIRED for unmarked Chinook and steelhead.**
- **Soak times are limited to 45 minutes** (timed from when net enters the water until complete net removal from water).
- **Notice of Intent REQUIRED** to participate in any of the days in this fishery below by 12 pm, Noon, October 4, 2013.
- **Quick Reporting REQUIRED** for wholesale dealers by 10 AM the day following landing.
- All participants **MUST** have attended a "Fish Friendly" best fishing practices workshop and have in their immediate possession a department-issued certification card.
- **Retention of Green Sturgeon Prohibited.** Please report ALL encounters to Wholesale Dealer or through the Quick Reporting phone, fax, or email.
