To help mitigate adverse affects caused by our road reconstruction project, we agree to expend up to \$20,000 on other road related habitat improvement projects in Clallam County proposed by the Department of Game. This habitat improvement shall be constructed within three (3) years of this date. This expenditure is to make up for loss of fish habitat and production due to our reconstruction work. This amount is based on your estimate, and expenditure of this money is to release Clallam County from the requirement of constructing a fish ladder on the subject stream.

MITIGATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 18<sup>th</sup> day of September 1984 by and between the BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, hereinafter referred to as "Clallam County", and the STATE OF WASHINGTON, DEPARTMENT OF GAME, hereinafter referred to as "GAME".

WHEREAS, Clallam County is willing to mitigate adverse impacts to fish habitat caused by their road reconstruction project (Hoko-Ozette Road Fill Project, Sec 5, T 31, R 13 W, W.M.); and

WHEREAS, Game is willing to accept the following mitigation agreement for the afore mentioned road reconstruction project, now, therefore,

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

(1) Based on Game's recommendations, Clallam County will expend up to \$20,000 on stream habitat enhancement projects in Clallam County within the next three years.

(2) Game will provide to Clallam County, requests for specific proposed projects. Clallam County will review and provide Game an itemized cost estimate for each proposed project. Game will select projects to be developed based upon resource benefits, feasibility and cost.

(3) In the event Clallam County is unable to complete development of the proposed habitat improvement projects within three years, \$20,000 or the unused portion thereof shall be transferred to Game for stream enhancement in Clallam County.

(4) The term of this agreement shall be from the date of its execution through and including three calendar years.


(5) This agreement does not in any way relieve Clallam County of their responsibilities to provide mitigation as required by law for future Clallam County projects.



Currently there is one GS-12 F&WL Staff Officer and one GS-11 Fisheries Staff Officer in the Supervisors Office that are directly responsible for the Fisheries Habitat Management Program. At District level, there is one Fisheries Biologist, one GS-9 Wildlife Biologist, one GS-7 Biological Technician, one GS-9 Zone Hydrologist, and one GS-9 ~~Other Resource Assistant~~ *Frank F. Fisher* that have fisheries habitat management responsibilities. At present, none of the previously mentioned personnel are working fulltime with the Fisheries Habitat Management Program.
