FOR THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 21ST - OCTOBER 27TH ALL AREAS ARE CLOSED EXCEPT AS FOLLOWS:

Areas 7 and 7A (San Juan Islands and Point Roberts) will be open to:

Gillnets using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh:

7 AM to Midnight daily through Saturday October 27th

Purse seines with 5 inch strip:

7 AM to 6 PM daily through Saturday October 27th

Release all Chinook and coho. Brailing of catch and recovery boxes are required.

Reef nets:

5 AM to 9 PM daily through Saturday November 10th.

Release all Chinook.

Area 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:

Gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh:

Open continuously through 12 midnight Saturday October 27th.

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Open 7 AM to 6 PM daily Sunday October 21st through Saturday October 27th.

Area 8D (Tulalip Bay) will be open west of a line from Mission Point to Hermosa Point to:

Gillnets using 5 inch minimum mesh:

5 PM Sunday, October 21st to 9 AM Monday, October 22nd

5 PM Monday, October 22nd to 9 AM Thursday, October 25th

5 PM Thursday, October 25th to 9 AM Friday, October 26th

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Monday, October 22nd, 7 AM to 6 PM

Wednesday, October 24th, 7 AM to 6 PM

Release all Chinook.

Area 9A (Port Gamble Bay):

Open to skiff gillnets, with nets not to exceed 600 feet in length and 60 meshes in depth using 5-inch minimum mesh, continuously through 7 PM Saturday, October 27. All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

Areas 10 & 11 (Seattle and Tacoma) will be open to:

Gillnets using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh:

5 PM Sunday, October 21st to 9 AM Monday, October 22nd
Wednesday, October 24th, 4 PM to Midnight.

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Tuesday, October 23rd, 7 AM to 6 PM

Thursday, October 25th, 7 AM to 6 PM

Release all Chinook and coho.

Areas 12 & 12B (Hood Canal) will be open to:

Gillnets using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh:

Monday, October 22th, 7 AM to 8 PM

Wednesday, October 24th, 7 AM to 8 PM

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Tuesday, October 23rd, 7 AM to 6 PM

Thursday, October 25th, 7 AM to 6 PM


Release all Chinook.

On Thursday October 25th the area within 1 mile of the Hood Canal Bridge will be closed to purse seines. On October 25th, area 12 will be closed to purse seines north and east of a line from 47° 50' 20"N and 122° 37' 16"W, projected across the canal to a point at 47° 51' 22"N and 122° 39' 7"W, then projected true north to the shoreline. A map of this area is attached to this hotline on WDFW's website.

Fishers are reminded that a department issued **Fish Friendly certification card is required** to participate in any Area 7 or 7A commercial salmon fisheries (including chum fisheries).
