**For the remainder of the week beginning Sunday September 22<sup>nd</sup> all non-Fraser Panel controlled areas are closed except as follows:**

**Area 6D (Dungeness Bay) will be open to:**

**Skiff gillnets** using 5-inch minimum mesh from 7 AM to 7 PM daily  
Wednesday, September 25  
Thursday, September 26  
Friday, September 27  
All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

**Areas 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:**

**Gillnets** using 5-inch minimum mesh size:  
Continuously until midnight Saturday, October 26

**Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:  
Continuously until 6 PM Saturday, October 26  
Sockeye must be released.

**Area 8D (Tulalip Bay) will be open west of a line from Mission Point to Hermosa Point to:**

**Gillnets** using 5 inch minimum mesh size:  
6 PM Monday, September 23 to 8 AM Thursday, September 26  
6 PM Thursday, September 26 to 8 AM Friday, September 27

**Area 9A (Port Gamble Bay) will be open to:**

**Skiff gillnets** using 5-inch minimum mesh, continuously through 7 PM Saturday, October 26.  
All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

**Area 12A (Quilcene Bay) will be open to:**

**Beach seines** daily 7 AM to 7 PM  
Monday, September 23 through Friday, September 27
