Gear	Gillnets, no minimum mesh size restriction	
Area	Zone 6 (SMCRA 1F, 1G, 1H)	
Sanctuaries:	Standard river mouth and dam sanctuaries applicable to these gear types. The Spring Creek Hatchery Sanctuary is not necessary this time of year.	
Allowable Sales:	Chinook, steelhead, sockeye, walleye, shad, yellow perch, bass and carp may be sold, or retained for subsistence. Sturgeon may not be sold. Sturgeon between 43-54 inches in fork length in The Dalles and John Day pools may be retained for subsistence. Sturgeon between 38-54 inches in fork length in the Bonneville pool may be retained for subsistence.
