

COLUMBIA RIVER COMPACT/JOINT STATE ACTION NOTICE

The following table outlines current regulations for treaty Indian fisheries adopted by the Columbia River Compact, including today's action regarding the Platform Hook and Line fishery below Bonneville Dam effective 6 AM Thursday June 9, 2011.

2011 Treaty Indian Platform/Hook and Line/Commercial Fishery	
Area:	Zone 6 (SMCRA 1F, 1G, 1H)
Season:	6:00 p.m. Tuesday May 10 until further notice: Sale of fish caught from platforms and hook and line in Zone 6 are allowed.
Allowable Sales:	Salmon, steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, and yellow perch. Sturgeon may be retained for subsistence only.
Miscellaneous:	<u>24-hour quick reporting</u> required for Washington wholesale dealers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240.
2011 Yakama Nation Tributary Fisheries	
Area:	Wind River, Drano Lake, White Salmon River, Klickitat River
Season:	6:00 p.m. Tuesday May 10 until further notice: Sale of fish caught from Yakama Nation tributary fisheries are allowed for Yakama Nation enrolled members only when those areas are open under lawfully enacted Yakama Nation rules.
Allowable Sales:	Salmon, steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, and yellow perch.
Miscellaneous:	<u>24-hour quick reporting</u> required for Washington wholesale dealers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240.
2011 Treaty Indian Platform Hook and Line below Bonneville Dam	
Spring Season	June 7 and June 8, open hours 6AM- 8PM daily, and 6:00 AM Thursday June 9 through Midnight Wednesday June 15.
Areas:	Below Bonneville Dam, as prescribed in tribal MOUs/MOAs
Gear:	Hook and line. Bank fishing only. One pole per fisher only
Allowable Sales:	Salmon, steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, and yellow perch. Sturgeon retention is prohibited; sturgeon may not be sold or retained for ceremonial or subsistence purposes. Sales may not occur on USACE property.
Miscellaneous:	Tribal members fishing below Bonneville Dam must carry an official tribal enrollment card. <u>24-hour quick reporting</u> required for Washington wholesale dealers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240.
