| <b>Area:</b>  | <b>Zone 6</b> (SMCRA 1F, 1G, 1H)  |
| <b>Season:</b>  | Effective 6:00 p.m. Tuesday May 10 until further notice: Sale of fish caught from platforms and hook and line in Zone 6 are allowed.  |
| <b>Allowable Sales:</b>   | Salmon, steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, and yellow perch. Sturgeon may be retained for subsistence only.   |
| <b>Miscellaneous:</b>   | <u>24-hour quick reporting</u> required for Washington wholesale dealers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240.   |
| <b>2011 Yakama Nation Tributary Fisheries</b>                         |   |
| <b>Area:</b>  | Wind River, Drano Lake, White Salmon River, Klickitat River   |
| <b>Season:</b>  | Effective 6:00 p.m. Tuesday May 10 until further notice: Sale of fish caught from Yakama Nation tributary fisheries are allowed for Yakama Nation enrolled members only when those areas are open under lawfully enacted Yakama Nation rules. |
| <b>Allowable Sales:</b>   | Salmon, steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, and yellow perch.  |
| <b>Miscellaneous:</b>   | <u>24-hour quick reporting</u> required for Washington wholesale dealers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240.   |
| <b>2011 Treaty Indian Platform Hook and Line below Bonneville Dam</b> |   |
| <b>Season</b>   | Effective 6:00 p.m. Tuesday May 10 until 8:00 p.m. May 14, 2011: Sale of fish caught prior to 8:00 p.m. May 14, 2011, from hook and line are allowed.   |
| <b>Areas:</b>   | Below Bonneville Dam, as prescribed in tribal MOUs/MOAs   |
| <b>Gear:</b>  | Hook and line. Bank fishing only.   |
| <b>Allowable Sales:</b>   | Salmon, steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, and yellow perch. <b>Sturgeon retention is prohibited;</b> sturgeon may not be sold or retained for ceremonial or subsistence purposes. Sales may not occur on USACE property.         |
| <b>Miscellaneous:</b>   | Tribal members fishing below Bonneville Dam must carry an official tribal enrollment card. <u>24-hour quick reporting</u> required for Washington wholesale dealers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240.  |
