COLUMBIA RIVER COMPACT/JOINT STATE HEARING

July 21, 2011

<i>2011 Treaty Indian Summer Chinook Commercial Fishery</i>	
Season	6 AM Monday July 25 to 6 PM Saturday July 30, 2011 (5.5 days)
Area	Zones 6
Sanctuaries:	Standard river mouth and dam sanctuaries apply. No Spring Creek hatchery sanctuary is necessary this time of year.
Gear:	Gill nets with a minimum stretched mesh size of 7.25 inches.
Allowable Sales:	Chinook, coho, steelhead, shad, yellow perch, bass, walleye, catfish and carp may be sold or retained for subsistence. Sockeye may not be sold, but may be retained for subsistence. Sturgeon may not be sold, but sturgeon from 43 to 54 inches fork length in The Dalles and John Day Pools and from 38 to 54 inches fork length in the Bonneville Pool may be kept for subsistence purposes. Sales of fish caught during open period gillnet periods are allowed after the end of the open period, as long as the fish were landed during the open period.
Additional:	24-hour quick reporting rule is in effect for Washington buyers.
