The States met today and took the following action on the recreational sturgeon fisheries in the estuary and in the Bonneville Pool.

2013 Recreational White Sturgeon Fishery Below Wauna

Prohibit retention of white sturgeon effective 12:01 AM Friday, June 21, 2013 in the mainstem Columbia River from the Wauna powerlines downstream to the mouth at Buoy 10, including Youngs Bay, and all adjacent Washington tributaries.

2013 Recreational White Sturgeon Fishery in Bonneville Pool

Prohibit retention of white sturgeon effective 12:01 AM Saturday, June 22, 2013 in the mainstem Columbia River from Bonneville Dam upstream to The Dalles Dam (Bonneville Pool) including all adjacent tributaries.

- A fall Compact hearing is scheduled for 10 AM Thursday July 25 at the Wahkiakum County Courthouse (3rd Floor) in Cathlamet, Washington.
