THE FOLLOWING SEASONS WERE SET:

<i>2014 Treaty Fall Platform and Hook and Line Fishery</i>	
Season	Open through 6:00 PM , December 31, 2014 (consistent with tribal regulations)
Area	SMCRA 1F, 1G, 1H (Zone 6) and the area immediately downstream of Bonneville Dam within SMCRA 1E as described in tribal/state MOUs and MOAs.
Gear:	Hoop Nets, Dip Nets, and hook and line
Sanctuaries:	Standard sanctuaries applicable to these gear types.
Allowable Sales:	<p>Salmon, steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, or yellow perch. Sturgeon may not be sold EXCEPT: In The Dalles pool (SMCRA 1G), sturgeon between 43-54 inches in fork length may only be sold only if sales are concurrently allowed in the fall sturgeon set-line season.</p> <p>Sturgeon may be kept for subsistence in all pools if between 38-54 inches in fork length in the Bonneville Pool and 43-54 inches in fork length in The Dalles and the John Day pools.</p> <p>In the area downstream of Bonneville Dam, sturgeon may not be kept or sold and sales of fish may not occur on USACE property.</p> <p>Sales of fish are permissible after an open period concludes, as long as the fish offered for sale were landed during an open period.</p>
Additional:	<p>24-hour quick reporting required for Washington buyers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240 except that landings must be reported within 24-hours of completing the fish ticket. Submission of a report is not complete until the report arrives at the designated department location.</p> <p>Reports can be made via fax at 360-906-6776 or 360-906-6777; via e-mail at crfishtickets@dfw.wa.gov; or via phone at 1- 866-791-1281.</p> <p>Faxing or reporting electronically in portable document format (PDF) a copy of each fish receiving ticket used, within the previously indicated time frames specified per area, satisfies the quick reporting requirement.</p>

- Sales of fish caught in Yakama Nation tributary fisheries continue to be allowed.
- No Columbia River Compacts are currently scheduled.
