The Joint States met today and took the following action:

<i>Lower Columbia Recreational Salmon Fishery</i>

Effective June 3 through June 15, 2015
--

From the Tongue Point/Rocky Point line upstream to the to the Oregon/Washington border
--

The daily bag limit includes two adult salmonids per day. Release sockeye. Only adipose fin-clipped salmon and steelhead may be kept. All other permanent regulations apply.
--

- Increases the daily hatchery adult Chinook limit to two fish.

A Compact is scheduled via teleconference at 1:00 PM Thursday June 4 to consider treaty fisheries.
