The States met today and took the following action:

<i>2015 Mainstem Columbia River Summer Chinook Recreational Fishery</i>	
Season:	Open through July 31, 2015
Area:	Astoria-Megler Bridge upstream to the Bonneville Dam deadline.
Daily Bag	<u>Through July 2:</u> Two adult salmonids.
Limit:	Sockeye are included in the adult daily limit Chinook and steelhead must be adipose fin clipped.
	<u>July 3-31:</u> Two adult salmonids, only one may be a Chinook Sockeye are included in the adult daily limit. Steelhead must be adipose fin clipped.

<i>2015 Mainstem Columbia River Summer Chinook Recreational Fishery</i>	
Effective July 3, 2015: in the area from Bonneville Dam upstream to the Oregon/Washington border the daily bag limit will include: Two adult salmonids, only one may be a Chinook. Sockeye are included in the adult daily limit. Steelhead must be adipose fin clipped.
