Columbia River Compact/ Joint State Action Notice Washington Dept. of Fish and Wildlife

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

TREATY INDIAN COMMERCIAL SEASON

- Area: All of Zone 6
- Dates: 6:00 AM, Friday, May 4, 2001 through 6:00 PM, Saturday, May 5
- Gear: No mesh restriction
- Allowable Sale: Salmon, steelhead, walleye and shad. Sturgeon sales are not allowed. Sturgeon between 4 feet and 5 feet may be retained for subsistence.
- Sanctuaries: All standard sancturaries remain in effect with the exception of the Spring Creek Hatchery Sanctuary.

MAINSTEM COLUMBIA RIVER SPRING CHINOOK SPORT FISHERY:

- Area: The Dalles and John Day Pools
- Dates: 12:01 AM, Sunday, May 6, 2001 through 11:59 PM, Tuesday, May 8
- Allowable Catch: Adipose fin-clipped Chinook salmon, adipose fin-clipped steelhead, and shad may be retained. Non-adipose fin clipped salmon and steelhead must be released immediately unharmed. The daily limit is 6 salmon, no more than two adults.
