## Columbia River Compact/ Joint State Action Notice

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

NON-INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

Coho/Sturgeon Fishery

Area: Zone 1-5, except those areas from Longview Bridge upstream to a line projected from Warrior Rock to Red Buoy No 4 thence to a fishing boundary marker on Bachelor Island.

Sanctuaries: Grays Bay, Elokomin-A, and Abernathy Creek, Washougal River, and Sandy River sanctuaries are in place.

Dates: 7 AM to 7 PM - Monday, October 9, 2000  
7 AM to 7 PM - Monday, October 16, 2000

Gear: Unslackened floater gill nets with 6" maximum mesh size or 9" minimum and 9 ¾" maximum mesh size gillnets.

Allowable Sale: Salmon and sturgeon

Coho Target Season

Area: Zone 1-5, except those areas from Longview Bridge upstream to a line projected from Warrior Rock to Red Buoy No 4 thence to a fishing boundary marker on Bachelor Island.

Sanctuaries: Grays Bay, Elokomin-A, and Abernathy Creek, Washougal River, and Sandy River sanctuaries are in place.

Dates: 12:00 PM (noon), Tuesday, October 10, 2000 - 12:00 PM (noon), Friday, October 13, 2000.  
12:00 PM (noon), Tuesday, October 17, 2000 - 12:00 PM (noon), Friday, October 20, 2000

Gear: Unslackened floater gill nets with 6" maximum mesh size restriction.
