September 10, 2001

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

Treaty Indian Commercial Gillnet Fishery:

Area:	All of Zone 6
Dates:	6:00 AM, Tuesday, September 11, 2001 to 6:00 PM, Saturday, September 15.
Gear:	No mesh size restrictions
Sanctuaries:	Creek sanctuary 150' radius around ladder. All other standard sanctuaries in place.
Allowable Sale:	Chinook, coho, steelhead, walleye and shad.
Other:	Commercial sale of platform/hook & line fish may be sold.
Miscellaneous Regulations:	Sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet long may be retained for subsistence use only. Fish caught in the Klickitat River may be sold when the Klickitat River is open.
