THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

Non-Indian Commercial Coho Fishery:

AREA: From the Mouth upstream to Longview Bridge

DATES: 7AM to 7PM Monday, September 17
7AM to 7PM Tuesday, September 18
7AM to 7PM Wednesday, September 19

GEAR: Unslackened floater gill nets with 6" maximum mesh size restriction. The use of monofilament gillnet gear is allowed.

ALLOWABLE SALE: Salmon only. No sturgeon sales allowed.

SANCTUARIES: Grays Bay and Elokomin-A

Non-Indian Commercial Chinook Fishery:

AREA: I-205 Bridge upstream to Beacon Rock

DATES: 8PM Monday, September 17 to 6AM, Tuesday, September 18

GEAR: 8" minimum mesh size restriction. The use of monofilament gillnet gear is allowed

ALLOWABLE SALE: Salmon only. No sturgeon sales allowed.

SANCTUARIES: Washougal and Sandy

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE AMENDED:

Select Area commercial salmon fishery

AREA: Deep River Fishing Area

DATES: 7PM Sunday to 7AM Monday during September 16-29
6PM Sunday to 8AM Monday during September 30-October 31

Adds Sunday nights to already adopted seasons. Allows the use of monofilament gillnets effective Sunday, September 16, 2001.
