## Columbia River Compact Joint State Action Notices Washington Dept. of Fish and Wildlife

August 18, 2004

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:  
Non-Indian Commercial Salmon Fishery

DATES: 7 PM Thursday August 19 to 7AM Friday August 20 (12 hours)  
AREA: Zones 3-5  
SANCTUARIES: Cowlitz River, Kalama-A, Lewis-A, Washougal and Sandy Rivers.  
GEAR: 8-inch minimum and 9 ¾-inch maximum mesh size restrictions.  
ALLOWABLE SALES: Salmon. No sturgeon sales allowed for mainstem fishery.  
MISCELLANEOUS RULES: Quick Reporting Rules will be in effect for Washington buyers.

Quick Reporting Rule in effect for Washington wholesale dealers, WAC 220-69-240.

### Quick Reporting Rule for Washington Buyers

WDFW has adopted rules that require commercial purchasers to report their landings by a specified time. This rule can be attached to any commercial season that is adopted, but is not in place unless specified. WDFW staff recommends that the "quick reporting required" clause be in place for this fishery. Washington buyers would be required to send a report of their landings to WDFW by 10AM on the day after the purchase date by either:
