THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

TREATY INDIAN COMMERCIAL SEASON:

Area: Bonneville and John Day pools only

Dates: 6:00 AM, Saturday, August 1, 2001 through 6:00 PM, Saturday, August 18, 2001

Gear: Setlines

Allowable Sale: Sturgeon

Sanctuaries: All standard dam and river mouth sanctuaries remain in effect.

Note: The setline season is currently open in these two pools. The season was extended through August 18, 2001.

TREATY INDAIN PLATFORM/HOOK AND LINE FISHERY:

Area: All of Zone 6

Dates: 6:00 AM Friday, July 20, 2001 through 6:00 PM Wednesday July 25, 2001

Gear: Hoop nets, dip nets, hook and line

Allowable Sale: Salmon, steelhead, shad, walleye

Other: Fish may be sold from the Klickitat River during July 20 through July 25 when the Klickitat River is open.

TREATY INDIAN PLATFORM/HOOK AND LINE FISHERY

Dates: 6AM Saturday, June 30 to 6PM Sunday July 15

Area: All of Zone 6 - platform fishery

Gear: Dipnet, hoopnet and hook & line

Allowable Sale: Sockeye, Chinook, steelhead, coho, shad, walleye. Sturgeon caught in Bonneville and John Day pools may also be sold.
