Columbia River Compact/ Joint State Action Notice Washington Dept. of Fish and Wildlife

August 22, 2001

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE AMENDED:

The Compact announced today that sturgeon retention would not be allowed for the last two days of the on going I-205 to Beacon Rock Fishery:

August 22, 2001 - No sturgeon retention,

August 23, 2001 - No sturgeon retention

The Compact also announced that sturgeon retention would not be allowed for the remainder of the 2001 Columbia River mainstem fall season.

Clarification of the Deep River Fishery:

ACTION #3:

AREA: Deep River fishing area

SEASON: Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday nights from September 4, 2001 to September 6, 2001.

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday nights from September 10, 2001 to October 31, 2001.

Open 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM through September 30 and 6:00 PM to 8:00 AM thereafter.

GEAR: 6-inch maximum mesh size restriction, maximum length of 100 fathoms, and no weight restriction on leadline.

ALLOWABLE SALE: Salmon only.
