NON-INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

Target coho fishery

Area:	Mouth upstream to Longview Bridge
Sanctuaries:	Grays Bay, Elokommin-A, and Abernathy Creek sanctuaries are in place.
Dates:	7 AM to 7 PM - Monday, September 25, 2000 7 AM to 7 PM - Tuesday, September 26, 2000 7 AM to 7 PM - Thursday, September 28, 2000 7 AM to 7 PM - Monday, October 2, 2000 7 AM to 7 PM - Tuesday, October 3, 2000 7 AM to 7 PM - Thursday, October 5, 2000
Gear:	September 25 - 28th 6-inch maximum mesh size restriction, unslackened floater gill nets only. During October 2 - 5th, 6-inch maximum mesh monofilament unslackened floater gillnets may be used as well.
Allowable Sale:	Salmon and sturgeon
