## Columbia River Compact/ Joint State Action Notice

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER COMMERCIAL NON-INDIAN SEASONS WERE SET:

### NON-INDIAN COMMERCIAL SOCKEYE FISHERY

- Dates: 6 PM June 28 to 6 AM June 29 (12 hours)  
6 PM June 29 to 6 AM June 30 (12 hours)  
6 PM June 30 to 6 AM July 1 (12 hours)
- Area: Area 2S (Beacon Rock downstream to Light 50)
- Gear: 4½ inch maximum mesh size. Single wall unslackened floater gill net.
- Allowable Sale: Non-adipose fin-clipped sockeye, chinook < 24 inches, shad, sturgeon. All adult salmon (> 24 inches), adipose fin-clipped sockeye, and steelhead must be released immediately.

### NON-INDIAN COMMERCIAL SHAD FISHERY

- Note: Non-Indian Commercial Shad Fishery in Area 2S was modified to allow the sale of chinook salmon  $\leq$  24 inches, non-adipose fin-clipped sockeye salmon, and sturgeon, during the following dates:
- Dates: 3 PM - 10 PM Wednesday June 28  
3 PM - 10 PM Thursday June 29  
3 PM - 10 PM Friday June 30
- Gear: All other regulations remain the same
