A COMPACT MEETING WAS HELD NOVEMBER 21, 2001 AND THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

### Treaty Indian Commercial Sturgeon Gillnet Fishery

SEASON: 6:00 AM Friday, November 23, 2001 to 6:00 PM Friday, November 30

AREA: Bonneville Pool only

SANCTUARIES: All standard river mouth and dam sanctuaries are in effect

GEAR: Diver gill nets with 8 1/2" minimum mesh size restriction

ALLOWABLE SALE: Sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet and walleye.

MISCELLANEOUS RULES: Sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet, salmon, and steelhead may be retained for subsistence use.

SEASON: 6:00 AM Friday, November 23, 2001 to 6:00 PM Friday, December 7

AREA: John Day Pool only

SANCTUARIES: All standard river mouth and dam sanctuaries are in effect

ALLOWABLE SALE: Sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet and walleye.

MISCELLANEOUS RULES: Sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet, salmon, and steelhead may be retained for subsistence use.
