## Columbia River Compact/ Joint State Action Notice

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

### NON-INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

The Compact modified the Target coho fishery that was set at the last Compact hearing. The fishery is now scheduled to occur only on Thursday, October 5. The Monday and Tuesday fishing days have been rescinded.

#### Target coho fishery

Area:	Mouth upstream to Longview Bridge
Sanctuaries:	Grays Bay, Elokomina-A, and Abernathy Creek sanctuaries are in place.
Dates:	7 AM to 7 PM - Thursday, October 5, 2000
Gear:	6-inch maximum mesh size restriction, unslackened floater gill nets only. 6-inch maximum mesh monofilament unslackened floater gillnets may be used as well.
Allowable Sale:	Salmon and sturgeon

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

### TREATY INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

Area:	John Day Dam to McNary Dam (Zone 63)
Sanctuaries:	Standard dam and river mouth sanctuaries in place.
Dates:	6 AM Monday, October 2, 2000 to 6 PM Sunday December 31, 2000 or until catch guideline of 1,160 is reached.
Gear:	Setline
Allowable Sale:	Sturgeon between 48 and 60 inches in length
