## Columbia River Compact Joint State Action Notices Washington Dept. of Fish and Wildlife

October 29, 2004

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:  
Yakima Nation Commercial Fishery - Klickitat River

- DATES:** 12:00PM (Noon) Tuesdays to 6PM Saturdays  
Beginning November 2 through December 25, 2004
- AREA:** Klickitat River from the mouth to the confluence with the Big Muddy Creek, provided that fishing is not allowed within 25 feet of the entrance to any fishway or inside the boundary markers at the Klickitat Hatchery.
- ALLOWABLE SALES:** Chinook and Coho only caught during the regular scheduled openings in the Klickitat River. Steelhead may be retained for subsistence but not sold.
- OTHER:** Sales outside the Klickitat Falls area are by special transfer permit only. All Yakama Nation regulations apply.

### TREATY INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

Commercial Sale Of Platform Hook & Line Or Caught Fish Prohibited

- DATES:** 6:00 PM Oct 31 thru Dec 31, 2004
- AREA:** Zone 6
- ALLOWABLE SALES:** Commercial sales of all platform or hook and line caught fish, including salmon and steelhead, are prohibited. Salmon and steelhead may continue to be retained for subsistence purposes only. The sale of Sturgeon is also prohibited, but sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet in length may be kept for subsistence use only in The Dalles and John Day pools. Sturgeon between 45-60 inches in length may be kept for subsistence use only in the Bonneville pool.
- OTHER:** Commercial sales of fish caught during the Klickitat fishery are allowed under Yakama Nation regulations
