THE FOLLOWING ACTION WAS TAKEN:

Treaty Indian Commercial Gillnet Fishery

SEASON: 6AM Tuesday July 5, 2005 through
6PM Thursday July 7, 2005 (2.5 Days)

AREA: All of Zone 6

SANCTUARIES: All standard sanctuaries in effect, except no Spring Creek
Sanctuary

GEAR: No mesh size restrictions

Treaty Indian Platform/ Hook and Line Fishery

SEASON: 6AM Monday July 4, 2005 through July 31, 2005

AREA: All of Zone 6

GEAR: No mesh size restrictions

ALLOWABLE SALES: - Chinook, sockeye, coho, steelhead, walleye, carp, and shad.
- The sale of Sturgeon is prohibited.
- Sturgeon between 45-60 inches in length sturgeon in the Bonneville pool and between 4 feet and 5 feet in length in The Dalles and John Day pools. may be kept for subsistence use only.

- Sale of fish caught in the platform/hook and line fishery will be allowed. Fish caught during open fishing periods in the Klickitat and White Salmon rivers tributary fisheries may be sold when the sale of platform and hook-and-line fish is allowed.

Quick Reporting Rule for Washington Buyers
WAC 220-69-240

WDFW has adopted rules that require commercial purchasers to report their landings by a specified time. Washington buyers are required to send a report of their landings to WDFW by 10AM on the day after the purchase date by either:
