THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

Non-Indian Commercial Fishery:

AREA: Below Longview Bridge

SEASON: Six fishing days from September 5 through September 14, 2001

GEAR: 3-½ - 4-½ inch mesh. 150 fathoms maximum length

ALLOWABLE SALE: Adipose fin-clipped coho, and Chinook

SANCTUARIES: Grays, Elochoman-A, and Abernathy

OTHER: Open to participants in WDFW test fishery. A total of 25 brights per fisher may be sold. Must have an operating recovery box. A WDFW monitor must be on board.

Non-Indian Select Area Fishery:

AREA: Knappa Slough

SEASON: 7PM - 7AM Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday
September 4 through September 14, 2001

GEAR: No mesh restriction. 100 fathoms maximum length

ALLOWABLE SALE: Salmon
