Salmon Reports and Ringold Steelhead Reports**

**October 1-6, 2013**

**Hanford Reach Steelhead Fishery Summary**

The Columbia River from the Hwy 395 bridge (Kennewick/Pasco) upstream to the wooden Power line towers at the old Hanford town site open for the retention of Ringold origin hatchery steelhead on October 1. All steelhead must be adipose **and right ventral fin clipped** to be retained.

Very few boats targeted steelhead in this area this past week. The majority of the anglers continue to fish for fall Chinook. WDFW staff interviewed 355 anglers most of which were fishing primarily for salmon. A total of 110 steelhead were caught with 30 hatchery steelhead harvested.
