### **Salmon/Steelhead**

**Cowlitz River** – Winter run steelhead have edged out coho as the dominant catch.

**Kalama River** – Generally light effort and catches.

**Lewis River** – North Fork Lewis is still putting out Chinook, mainly for boat anglers.

**Washougal River** – Hatchery winter run steelhead and a few coho are being caught.

### **Trout**

**Klinline Pond** – 63 bank anglers kept 64 rainbows. The 1.25 pound average trout were mainly caught in the swimming area by anglers using Power Bait or Rapala plugs.
