Cooperative Compliance, Touchet Project Phase 1

The objective of this screens and passage construction project is to install fish screens meeting state and federal requirements at surface water diversions in the Walla Walla basin. Screening will be accomplished in two phases: this design and cost feasibility phase and a subsequent construction phase. The current grant agreement funds phase 1 activity on the Touchet River, a Walla Walla River tributary. This is a cooperative effort among WDFW, Department of Energy, county conservation districts, and local irrigators. Accomplishment of this phase will provide a basis for selecting the most needed or most potentially effective projects for construction.

Ahtanum Creek Barrier Inventory

The objective of this screens and passage inventory project is to document all fish passage barriers and unscreened or inadequately screened irrigation diversions in the Ahtanum Creek (Yakima River) basin. Data will be stored in the statewide fish passage and screening database maintained by WDFW Habitat Enhancement and Restoration Section. This inventory will provide a basis for evaluating basin-wide screening and passage needs and setting priorities for subsequent remedial work.
