### **MILITARY EXEMPTION FOR THE WASHINGTON ONLINE COURSE- FIELD EVALUATION**

Active members of the U.S. military are exempt from the range evaluation session of the Online Hunter Education Course. You **must send** your Washington State Exam Certificate, documents showing you are an active member of the United States Military, and this completed form to WDFW – Hunter Education Program at 600 Capitol Way North, Olympia, WA 98501-1091.

Documents typically submitted include, but not limited to, are:

- Uniformed Service I.D. / CAC
- Letter from your company commander, on letterhead, stating you are an active member of the armed forces

Members of United State Military means active-duty members of the United States Armed Forces, including the United States Coast Guard, Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, and Washington National Guard that are a resident of or stationed in Washington State.
