Dear Toledo Permit Holder:

Congratulations on being drawn for a Toledo Special Permit Hunt. These master hunter Toledo special permit hunts are designed to address damage issues within the Toledo area. Because of this, a second elk tag is offered to qualifying hunters that are drawn for these permit hunts. The second tag and retention of points is given as incentive to solicit help from master hunters in working with landowners to address elk damage issues.

Due to some confusion, the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife would like to clarify what is meant by the opportunity to purchase a second elk tag. Since the general season will not have started yet when your Toledo hunt takes place, you are given the option to purchase your second elk tag at the same time you purchase your first one. For the Toledo master hunter hunts, this second tag is to be used to harvest one elk during your Toledo hunt timeframe. The first or other tag, which you are in possession of, is to be used in the general elk season that fits your weapon choice. Only one elk is to be killed and tagged during your Toledo special permit hunt.

We hope to clarify this in the pamphlet in the future. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused and hope the intent of the second tag is now clear. Thank you for participating and please feel free to call if you have any further questions about this process.
