Purdy Cutoff Site

This Waterfowl Quality Hunt site is located just south of Hwy. 106 along the East Purdy Cutoff Road. Park at the large pull-off on the west side of the road. During high water events, the fields often flood and attract Canada geese and several species of puddle ducks. During drier periods, ducks may be found along the slough on the east border of the unit. The parking area may be crowded with salmon anglers until late in the season. This site is limited to one hunting party at a time. **The opportunity to hunt is on a first come/first served basis.** Only 3 hunters allowed in the party and no more than 15 shells per hunter. Pick up all empty shells and dead birds. Be considerate of other sportmen fishing on the river.
