

## West Deyette Rd. Blinds

From Hwy. 101, drive west on the Skokomish Valley Road from the WDFW fish hatchery on the highway. Go 1.7 miles and take a left on W. Deyette Rd. Go .2 miles to the "T" and take a left on the dirt road. Go .2 miles to the parking spot. Depending on rainfall, a four wheel drive vehicle may be required to use this site. There will be one blind to the north and one field to the south. The north blind is visible from the parking area. To get to the south field you'll need to cross through the hole in the fence to the north and walk to the bridge on your right. At the bridge you'll see hunting area in the second field to your right (south of the creek). You'll need to pass through three farm gates. Be sure to leave all gates as you found them. These sites may not attract waterfowl until heavy rainfall events. This may be as late as November or even December. Bring your own seat for the north blind and a portable blind if you choose to hunt the south field. **The opportunity to hunt is on a first come/first served basis. The first car parked at the sign reserves the entire field or blind.**
