Intended Uses	Water access
Project Description	<p>This acquisition would provide a significant fishing access to Wynoochee River. Angler access to middle Wynoochee River has been lost due to the owner gating the access road. This access is critical to the WDFW goal of reducing hatchery-origin fish on spawning grounds by increasing hatchery salmon and steelhead harvest opportunities. Angler participation and harvest in this area are expected to increase as steelhead angling opportunities are restricted in Puget Sound. Salmon species includes summer and winter run steelhead.</p>
