Intended Uses	Permanent conservation and recreation. Grazing will continue on part of the land. This parcel will become part of the Klickitat Wildlife Area.
Project Description	This parcel includes a healthy mix of ponderosa pine and Oregon white oak woodlands supporting a viable population of western gray squirrel. Bowman Creek provides year round water source for aquatic and wildlife species. The creek provides public fishing access on this popular trout fishing creek. Provides winter range habitat for black tailed deer and mule deer. Wildlife includes: ruffed grouse, white-breasted nuthatch, lazuli bunting and wild turkey.
