

**DRAFT List of Species Under Consideration for the  
Wildlife Areas Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP)**

**April 23, 2010**

As part of the development of the Wildlife Areas Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP), WDFW has conducted a statewide inventory of selected at-risk species that occur in the Wildlife Areas. WDFW anticipates seeking incidental take coverage for those species that 1) are of high conservation concern as designated by federal and state listing criteria; 2) occur or are likely to occur on the covered lands; and 3) are likely to be impacted by activities covered in the HCP. Below is a DRAFT species list for the Wildlife Areas HCP. WDFW is still in the development stages of the HCP and there is much uncertainty around which species will be included in the final HCP. **This list does not represent the final list of species for the HCP.**
