Davis Creek Unit

The Davis Creek Unit is a 550-acre former dairy farm acquired in 2007 for wetland conservation and wildlife-related recreation. It is managed by the WDFW for multiple uses, including as a working farm. In order to facilitate compatible public use opportunities, the rules and conditions listed below are in effect. Additional regulations apply per Title 232 WAC.

- This site is subject to firearm restrictions and nontoxic shot requirements. See WDFW hunting regulation pamphlets for specifics (QR below).
- Horseback riding is restricted to existing roads, except as allowed by WDFW permit.
- Prohibited (except by WDFW permit):
 - Overnight parking or camping
 - Motorized vehicle use
 - Open fires
 - Fireworks
