DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: TEMPORARY BRIDGE OVER PORTER LEVEE

Description of Proposal: The proposal will construct a temporary steel with wood decking bridge (30 feet by 10 feet) over the Porter Levee, which flows into the Green River, for access to a habitat restoration site. The bridge will remain until June, 2000.

Proponent: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

Location of Proposal, including street, if any: On the Green Valley Road, At Porter Levee next to King County-owned Park Land, Southeast of Auburn, Washington, King County; Section 21, Township 21 North, Range 05 East WM
