SEPA ENVIRONMENTAL CHECKLIST ADDENDUM

Name of Proposal: FISHWAY GENERAL MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

Description of Proposal: General maintenance activities for 71 Department of Fish and Wildlife fishway sites located statewide. Includes the following activities needed to safely pass fish: 1) removal of accumulated organic and inorganic materials, 2) replacement of stop logs and guides associated with weir/pool, vertical slot or pool chute type fishways, 3) repair or replacement of concrete weirs/walls associated with concrete fishways, 4) repair or replacement of metal trash racks, guides, screens, ladders and grates associated with weir/pool or vertical slot fishways, and 5) repair or replacement of log controls, ballast, and associated rip-rap associated with log control type fishways.

Proponent: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

Location of Proposal, including street, if any:

71 fishway sites owned by the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife located statewide (see attached table of specific locations, and includes Salt Creek, River Mile 3.4, West of Freshwater Bay, Washington, Clallam County, Northwest 1/4 of Section 34, Township 31 North, Range 08 West, WM (Addendum dated 1/20/00).

Lead Agency: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

The lead agency is providing updated information on this project which may be of interest to other agencies or the public. The updated information provided below does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts in the existing environmental checklist.

The original environmental checklist dated January 21, 1997 should be modified to reflect the following additions:


