**ADDENDUM TO DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
DATED: June 25, 2001 (Final on July 11, 2001)**

Name of DNS: ELGIN-PARR HABITAT IMPROVEMENT TIMBER SALE

Description of DNS: The proponent is proposing a timber sale designed for improving mule deer winter range habitat. The sale will reduce the density of Douglas Fir.

Proponent: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife, Wildlife Program, 201 North Pearl Street, Ellensburg, Washington 98926. Contact Person: Douglas Kuehn, Wildlife Forester

Location of DNS, including street, if any: One Mile North of Fish Lake on the Conconully Road and Approximately Thirteen Miles South of Loomis, Washington, Okanogan County; Portions of Sections 04, 09 and 10, Township 36 North, Range 25 East WM

Lead Agency: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

The lead agency is providing updated information on this project which may be of interest to other agencies or the public. The updated information provided below does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts in the existing environmental checklist.

The original environmental checklist dated 6/21/01, should be modified to reflect the following additions:

A. Background

7. Portions of Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 36 North, Range 25 East WM, totaling 110 acres (acres already included in DNS) with the same prescription for improving mule deer winter range on the Sinlahekin Wildlife Area. (Portions of Section 3 have been added.)

9. Enclosure identifying WDFW (formerly Washington Dept. of Game) as the administrator for the management of the above lands.

11. Acres for the addendum are already included in these figures but they will be thinned in addition to the prescribed burn. (216 forested acres and 200 non-forested acres in original checklist.)

12. Approximately 10 acres are included along the **west boundary of S 3, Lot 4**, 80 acres in Section 4, East ½ of the Southeast ¼ and 20 acres of Section 9, Portions of the South ½ of the Southeast ¼ of Township 36 North, Range 25 East. (Section 3, Lot 4 has been added.)

Ownership includes: BLM parcels in Section 3. DNR, BLM and WDFW own parcels in Section 4 and 9. WDFW owns parcels in Section 10.

B. Environmental Elements.

4. Plants

An additional gross volume of 183.31 MBF Douglas Fir and 53,74 MBF Ponderosa Pine were marked to cut with orange paint.


