ADDENDUM TO DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of DNS: BIG VALLEY WILDLIFE AREA IRRIGATION WELL

Description of DNS: The proponent is planning to drill a well, 10 to 12 inches in diameter and approximately 100 feet deep, to provide irrigation water to approximately 120 acres of farm land now serviced by the Rockview Ditch.


