### REVISED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE WITH CONDITIONS

The Department of Fish and Wildlife has considered comments received on the original Threshold Determination for this project and is providing additional information which may be of interest to other agencies or the public. The information provided does not substantially change the analysis of the significant impacts in the existing environmental checklist.

**Name of Proposal:** TRI-RIVER RANCH SHOOTING PRESERVE

**Description of Proposal:** The proponent plans to establish a shooting preserve for released pheasants.

**The proponent shall incorporate the following mitigation measures into the project:**

1. The boundaries of the shooting preserve must be changed so the preserve is not located within one mile of a public hunting area owned or controlled by the department (Indian Dan and Pateros Wildlife Areas).
2. If WDFW biologists determine that sharp-tailed grouse occupy areas surrounding the preserve, then the shooting preserve permit may be reviewed to make sure allowing a shooting preserve is consistent with WDFW mandates.

**Location of Proposal, including street, if any:** Watson Draw Road, Approximately Five Miles North of Pateros, Washington, Okanogan County; South 1/2 of Section 3, the North 1/2 and Southwest 1/4 of Section 10, the West 1/2 of Section 11, and the Northeast 1/4 of Section 14 of Township 30 North, Range 23 East WM

**Lead Agency:** Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of the completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

**There is no comment period for the Revised DNS.**


